## CT SCAN TRANSFER SETUP CHECKLIST

Liaise with CT for a time. 61830/62897
Check patient has wristband.
PET-T trolley. Ensure O2 cylinders are both > 75% full. Attach to end of bed.
Ensure end of bed has not been extended (will not fit in lift).
Transfer bag (sealed and checked).
Drug boxes (sealed red and clear)
Portable ventilator with sufficient charge & tubing. Attach to wall O2 and medical
team will set up.
Monitor with sufficient charge.
Portable suction with sufficient charge.
Mapleson C circuit with O2 flow connector.
Remove and disconnect flowtrons.
Disconnect any unnecessary infusions. TPN can be stopped but must remain
connected.
Stop, aspirate, and disconnect feed. Stop VRII.
Draw up infusions into braun pumps (Check charge and consider spare drugs
depending on infusion rate). Place into transfer brackets no more than two pumps
per bracket.
If contrast scan, ensure appropriate working venous access.
Additional equipment such as aspen collar, clamps for chest drains, tracheostomy
equipment etc.
Check blood glucose before departure > 4 mmol/l.
Disconnect mattress.
Book porters in a timely manner.
