THEATRE TRANSFER SETUP CHECKLIST

Liaise with theatre for a time.
Check patient has wristband.
Ensure surgical pathway and consent has been complete.
If consent 4 ensure best interest meeting is complete (EPR).
Check G&S has been sent if applicable.
Equipment from CCU should be used and then returned with patient.
PET-T trolley should not be used.
Portable ventilator with sufficient charge & tubing. Attach to wall O2 and medical
team will set up (if ventilated).
Use full F size O2 cylinder from back of bedspace.
Draw up infusions into braun pumps (check charge and consider spare drugs
depending on infusion rate). Place into transfer brackets no more than two pumps per
bracket.
Unplug brick when theatre staff arrive. If ventilated use T1 handle to get Co2 trace.
Remove and disconnect flowtrons.
Disconnect any unnecessary infusions. TPN can be stopped but must remain
connected.
Stop, aspirate, and disconnect feed. Stop VRII.
Check blood glucose before departure > 4 mmol/l.
Disconnect mattress.
Update NOK on departure/return.
